Client Profiles and Implementation Models

Health Services Provider offers their patients a PHR

- St. Joseph's Health System, Sonoma County, provides mobile health and mobile dental services in Sonoma Valley and uses MiVIA as it's PHR / EMR lite
- Members are enrolled on site by Promotoras who offer outreach and enrollment into health programs and services, clinicians use MiVIA as EMR – Lite.
- PHR / EMR lite – provides continuity of care for members, more complete health histories for follow up visits

Outreach Center Expands Services

Vineyard Workers Services is a Sonoma Valley outreach center providing temporary housing for migrant and seasonal farm workers.

- Link clients to the St. Joseph's Health System mobile health clinic.
- Offers MiVIA enrollment in their office, weekly computer classes, and provide the MiVIA emergency card.
- MiVIA emergency card has become a reason farm workers come to VWS.

Networking Safety Net Providers through Outreach

California Human Development Corporation (CHDC) – San Joaquin County

- Existing jobs training and outreach resource agency expands to include health education, outreach, and enrollment into MiVIA
- Mobile classroom on wheels offers on-site health outreach and MiVIA enrollment with referrals for care to local health programs
- Serves migrant workers and their families, unemployed, uninsured, and homeless in San Joaquin county
- Network of care providers support the MiVIA referral program, CHDC offers office hours for MiVIA support

Building community support for the local hospital system:

Delano Regional Medical Center, Kern County

- A DRMC sponsored community outreach worker builds local support and loyalty to the hospital system by offering health education and MiVIA enrollment through hospital based clinics.
- The MiVIA program seeks to increase utilization of hospital resources by the local community by offering enrollment into MiVIA and issuing the emergency card to members of the community at large.

Public Health Department connects patients and clinicians

- Pender County, N.C. Public Health Department uses MiVIA to link programs, providers and patients
- Mobile Health, Diabetes Clinic, Pediatrics, local Community Clinic, Maternity and Child Health clinic, and more will all use MiVIA as an EMR lite/ PHR to link patient information with the providers that serve them

Community HIN

- The Providence Health System owned Mobile Health Clinic uses MiVIA as it's EMR lite, enrolling members as it provides care in distant locations (no patient interface offered)
- Referrals for ongoing care are made to the local FQHC
- Providers at the clinic staff the van and the hospital, creating a provider based, community wide HIN

Migrant Health Program

Finger Lakes Migrant Health Care Project, New York State

- MiVIA is used to link FLMHCP patient records among providers, including specialty and telemedicine providers

- Track blood glucose, carbohydrates
- Learn more about diabetes
- Create and track a self-management plan
- Share their information with their doctors

Care Coordination

St. Joseph's Health System, Humboldt County: Care Transitions Program

Chronically ill patients discharged from the hospital are being linked with nursing students for enrollment into MiVIA and post-hospitalization care coordination

Homeless and Foster Care Youth Pilot Project

MiVIA is being used to pilot a new and expanded application for homeless youth and aged out Foster Care youth in Sacramento, CA.

Issues include:

- youth carry no ID or paperwork
- they have no health histories, education histories, or work histories
- they are mobile, cross county and state jurisdictions
- they are often highly medicated when they are “in the system” and when they seek care it is severely fragmented
- Program seeks to identify services and resources as well as serve as a medical / informational “home” which can be maintained and built upon

Research

- MiVIA projects are now being used for educational and research purposes in Universities across the nation.
- Usability in older adults / medication management
- Nurse case management
- Family practice residency training
- Special populations usability
- Homeless / Foster Care youth usability
- Continuity of care
