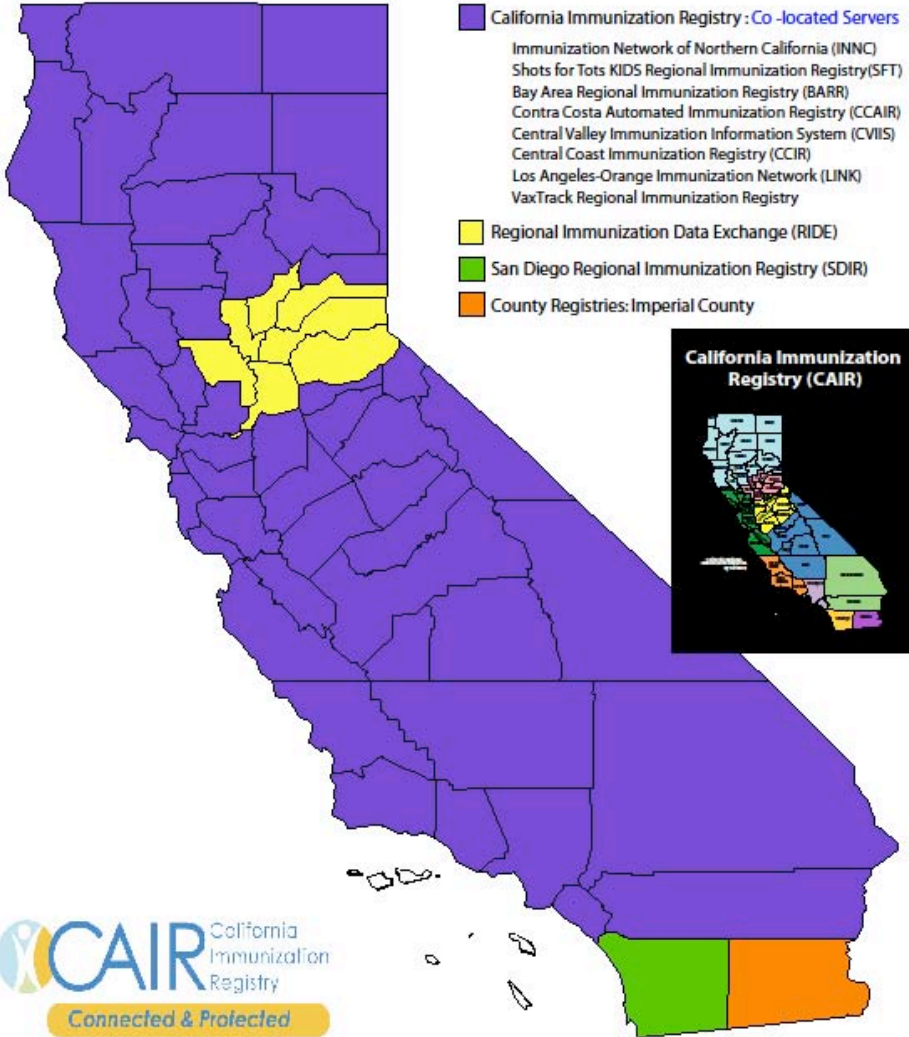


What's New?

- **Consolidation**
 - 7 of 10 regions use same software (CAIR) – 88% of state!
 - By November 2009, 7 databases will be brought together and managed centrally
- **Database 'Bridging'**
 - By end of 2009, 3 co-located regional databases will be 'bridged'
 - By summer 2010 all 7 regional databases will be bridged and 'connected' to the San Diego registry –allowing searches across 96% of the state!

CAIR and the HITECH Act

- **The ‘Meaningful Use’ recommendations for EHRs include:**
 - *Develop capabilities to exchange health information where possible*
 - » Participating providers throughout the state are currently exchanging information with CAIR using a variety of techniques including flat files and data extracts
 - » CAIR staff can offer guidance to providers on how they might share patient immunization information with CAIR
 - » EHR vendors are interested in working with CAIR to offer data exchange capability as part of their California product offerings
